GENERAL ORDER OF THE PRESIDING JUDGE

EMER ORDER 47

Public health agencies, including the CDC, the California Department of Public Health, and local county health departments have recommended health and safety measures targeted at reducing the spread of COVID-19. On February 28, 2022, the California Department of Public Health (Department) issued guidance strongly recommending, but no longer requiring, that everyone wear face coverings in indoor public settings, regardless of vaccination status. Additionally, on February 28, 2022, Governor Gavin Newsom issued Executive Order N-5-22 which, among other actions, suspends the Division of Occupational Safety and Health's (Cal/OSHA) regulations regarding face covering requirements for employees.

ORDER RESINCINDING FIFTH AMENDMENT TO GENERAL ORDER: FACE COVERINGS AND SOCIAL DISTANCE

Consequently, pursuant to California Rule of Court, rule 10.603, the Department's February 28, 2022, guidance regarding face coverings, and Executive Order N-5-22, the court HEREBY ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

While the court recommends that judges, employees, and members of the public wear face coverings when inside court facilities, the court's *Fifth Amended Order*Regarding Face Coverings and Social Distance, and all prior orders regarding Face

Coverings and Social Distance are rescinded as of March 7, 2022.

THIS ORDER IS EFFECTIVE March 7, 2022.
